Fall Session Begins Tuesday September 5, 2023

The Division B levels are designed for the more serious, experienced dance students who have made a commitment to their training. Students at this level are required to attend one ballet class per week when they are taking any other style of dance.

Required attire for Division B:

Ballet – Any color leotard, Ballet skirt, Pink tights, Pink ballet shoes/pointe shoes, Hair in a bun.

Jazz, Lyrical, Contemporary – Any color leotard, Fitted jazz shorts or leggings, Tan tights, Tan jazz shoes and Hair pulled up. Half soles for contemporary.

Hip-Hop – Any color tights, solid black sneakers.

Tap – Any color leotard, Fitted jazz shorts or leggings, Tan tights, Black flat tap shoes and Hair pulled up.

Conditioning – Dancers will need an exercise ball and sneakers.
